- 1 acre = 4840 square yards
- 1 furlong = 40 rods = 660 feet
- 1 chain = 100 links = 66 feet
- 1 rod = 16.5 feet
- 1 link = 7.92 inches

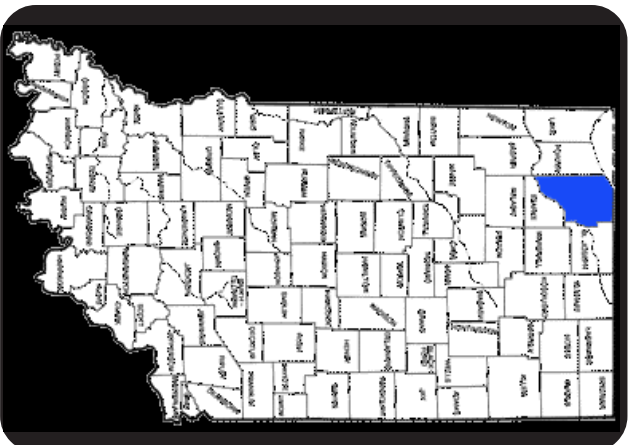
